At 0200 on 21 March 1955, a freight train which carried 20 to 25 T-54 tanks was seen on the Elsterwerda-Riesa railroad line en route toward Riesa. The shipment was ~~presumably~~ unloaded in Riesa. [redacted] 25X1

[redacted] tanks went from the Riesa railroad station to the Von-der-Goltz Kaserne (1802) in the early morning of that day. Fresh imprints of tank tracks led from the station to the installation mentioned. At 1230, a train of empty heavy-duty flatcars left Riesa toward Elsterwerda. The railroad cars were marked with the Polish Eagle and Polish inscriptions. 25X1

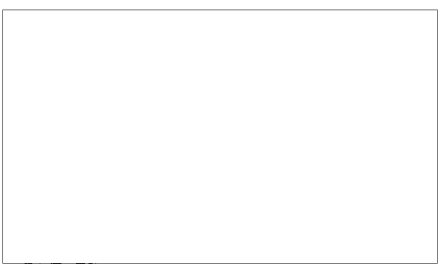
